Possible points may include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Democracy relies on stupid people. • Most people are stupid. • Reference to the analogy of the ship. • Belief that a philosopher king would be best/better. <p>Accept any other valid points and development.</p>	4

Explain two arguments for there being no god (atheism).</p>	<p>Award one mark for a quotation, and a further mark for explanation of that quote.</p> <p>Answers should quote problems with governments and link to how anarchy specifically should be enacted to fix these problems.</p> <p>If no direct reference to anarchy, max two marks can be awarded for selection of quotes.</p>	4
<p>3. Does god exist?</p> <p>Explain your answer You should discuss your opinions but also opinions that are counter to your own. Aim to come to a clear conclusion</p>	<p>For this question, use the following best fit from the table below.</p>	12

Level 1	Describes their own view, but may not provide much reasoning beyond assertion. Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)	1-3
Level 2	Describes their own view on god and will mention at least one argument for or against god, but these elements may not be connected explicitly. Fair SPaG – some mistakes. May not be structured very clearly.	4-6
Level 3	Explanations of both sides of the argument. Comes to a clear conclusion as to whether god exists or not. Good SPaG with some errors but a good structure.	7-9
Level 4	Detailed explanations of both sides of the argument. Comes to a clear conclusion as to the existence of god. Excellent SPaG – few errors and good structure.	10-12
