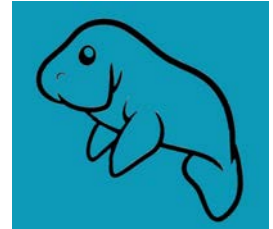

You should spend no more than 1 hour completing this paper.

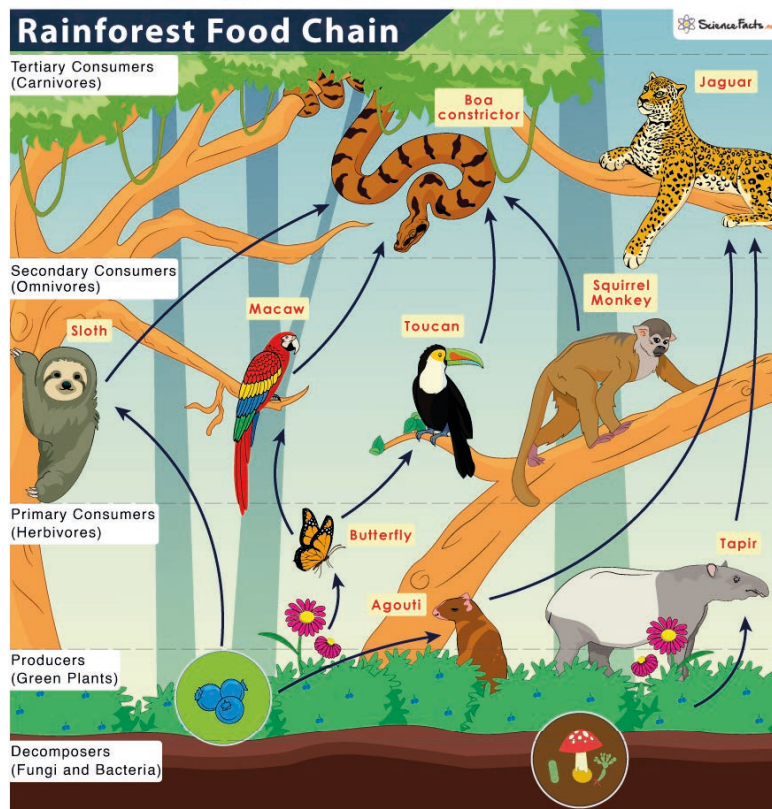
