Level 2	Explains some reasons to leave the forest alone OR some reasons to interact with it. OR Describes both some reasons to leave the forest alone AND some reasons to interact with it. Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.	4-7
Level 3	Complex explanations of both some reasons to leave the forest alone OR some reasons to interact with it. Excellent SPaG with very few errors.	8-10
