Level 2	Explains some reasons for OR against the statement. OR Describes some reasons from both sides of the statement. Uses a few facts about WW1 to make points. Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.	4-7
Level 3	Complex explanations of arguments BOTH for and against the statement. Uses a range of facts about WW1 Comes to a clear, reasoned opinion. Excellent SPaG with very few errors.	8-10
