There should be mention to at least four of these points: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • He tried to overthrow the government (in Munich) • He failed to take down the Munich government. • His troops were defeated. • He started a putsch in a Beer Hall. • He managed to persuade the judge at his trial to be on his side. • People (including the judge) supported his ideas. <p>A second mark may be awarded for a point if it has added detailed explanation.</p>	4

	b.	Give four reasons that Hitler gave for hating Jewish people.	Award marks any four of the following reasons. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • They control all the money/are too rich • They're communists. • They made Germany lose WW1. • They killed Jesus. • Other countries/people hate them. • They have been hated historically. • They 'killed his mum.' • They rejected his art. 	4

Be sure to come to a definite conclusion one way or the other.</p>	For this question, use the following best fit from the table below.

Level 1	<p>Describes some reasons for OR against the statement.</p> <p>Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)</p>	1-3
Level 2	<p>Explains some reasons for AND against the statement.</p> <p>OR</p> <p>Describes some reasons from both sides of the statement. Talks about other factors than just the treaty, e.g. <i>Mein Kampf</i>, the Reichstag Fire, anti-Semitism etc.</p> <p>Comes to a basic conclusion as to whether the statement is true or not but this may not be explained.</p> <p>Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.</p>	4-7
Level 3	<p>Complex explanations of arguments BOTH for and against the statement.</p> <p>Uses a range of factors other than the treaty (at least two others.)</p> <p>Comes to a clear, reasoned conclusion.</p> <p>Excellent SPaG with very few errors.</p>	8-10
