Explain how William won the battle.	<p>Award one mark for each point or for detailed explanation of a point</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • William used a mixed army of infantry, archers, cavalry. • William tricked Harold into dropping the shield wall. • Harold's troops did not listen to his orders. • Harold's army was tired due to marching. <p>Accept other valid points/explanations.</p>	4
4		Which man, Harold Godwinson, Harald Hardrada or William should have been king of England? Explain your answer. Aim to talk about both reasons for and against each man. Come to a justified conclusion.	For this question, use the following best fit from the table below.	

Level 1	Describes some reasons for ONE man being the best. Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)	1-3
Level 2	Explains some reasons for OR against two or three of the men. OR Describes some reasons for all three men being good AND bad for the job. Comes to a basic conclusion as to who the best king would be but this may not be explained. Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.	4-7
Level 3	Complex explanations of arguments for all three of the men being king. Comes to a clear, reasoned conclusion. Excellent SPaG with very few errors.	8-10
