2.	a.	In which country is Actium situated?	Greece 1
	b.	Describe four things that happened in the battle.	<p>Possible points that may be made:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Antony's army was suffering before the battle. • They were fighting for control of Rome. • Mark Antony fights Octavian. • Cleopatra was on Antony's side. • Cleo persuaded Antony to fight at sea. • Cleopatra ran away. • Antony followed her. <p>Any other relevant points can get marks too.</p>
3.	a.	How did Mark Antony die?	He killed himself. 1
	b.	Explain how Cleopatra died.	<p>Award marks any four of the following points.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • She was captured by Octavian. • She poisoned herself. • Her slaves died too. • She may have used a snake, or a poisoned needle. • The snake was hidden in a basket of fruit. • Cleo was dressed as a queen. • Octavian wanted to take her to Rome but she didn't want to go. <p>Award marks for any other relevant points.</p>
4		'Ceasar was a better boyfriend for Cleopatra than Antony.' Do you agree? Explain your answer. Aim to talk about both men and their positive and negative qualities. Be sure to come to a definite conclusion one way or the other.	For this question, use the following best fit from the table below.

Level 1	Describes some reasons for OR against the statement. Low quality of English – SpaG (Spelling, punctuation and grammar)	1-3
Level 2	Explains some reasons for OR against the statement. OR Describes some reasons from both sides of the statement. Comes to a basic conclusion as to whether the statement is true or not but this may not be explained. Good SPaG – some mistakes but not many.	4-7
Level 3	Complex explanations of arguments BOTH for and against the statement. Comes to a clear, reasoned conclusion. Excellent SPaG with very few errors.	8-10
